- 1. **Copies of at least two (2) pieces of identification.** We require <u>clear and legible</u> copies of your identification for anti-fraud purposes. Criteria for acceptable identification are outlined on page two. Please note: Your mailing address must match the address on your identification. If your mailing address is different from your identification, please also provide a current utility or credit card bill with your name and mailing address.
- Social Insurance Number (SIN). Royalties paid to you directly by Access Copyright are
 considered taxable income and Access Copyright requires your SIN for income-tax reporting
 purposes.

Acceptable Forms of Identification

Please provide us with a **photocopy** or scan of at least two (2) pieces of identification. All pieces must be valid (i.e. not expired) and at least one piece of identification must meet the following criteria: be government issued, include a photo, a signature and a mailing address.

Acceptable forms of federal, provincial and territorial government issued identification(s) include:

Federal Government:

- Canadian passport
- Certificate of Canadian citizenship or Permanent Resident Card
- Old Age Security card issued by the Government of Canada
- Canadian Armed Forces identity card
- Certificate of Indian Status issued by the Government of Canada

Provincial and Territorial Governments:

- Driver's licence
- Health card
- Birth, marriage or change of name certificates

Other forms of acceptable non-government issued ID with your name can include student cards, society membership cards, credit cards, etc.
